BRONZE MEDALLION

PUA20119 Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)

Overview:

The aim of the Bronze Medallion course is to develop your skills and knowledge so you can perform the role of a patrolling lifesaver on the beach. You will develop skills and knowledge in tube and board rescues, radios, communication and beach awareness when responding to aquatic emergencies during routine patrol duties.

This qualification includes a First Aid course (HLTAID011).

Entry Requirements:

- At least 15 years of age at date of assessment
- Complete a 400m pool swim in under 9minutes

When:

Course #1: Sunday to Thursday 17th – 21st Sept

Course #2: Sundays 22nd, 29th Oct; 12th, 26th Nov; 3rd Dec

Course #3: TBA if required after the Christmas break.

Excludes Surf Sport Carnivals 5th Nov, 19th Nov, 10th Dec 2023

FIRST AID

HLTAID011 Provide First Aid includes,

HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Overview:

This course is developed to meet the identified needs for a member wishing to extend their knowledge of providing first aid.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 14 years of age at date of assessment
- Must be a patrolling member OR enrolled in a course that will allow you to patrol (Minimum of 8 participants required)

When:

Saturday 2nd September 8:30am – all day

Monday 18th September 8:30am – all day

Sunday 29th October 8:30am – all day

Saturday 18th November 8:30am – all day

ADVANCED RESUSCITATION AND OXYGEN THERAPY

HLTAID015 Provide advanced resuscitation and oxygen therapy

Overview:

The aim of this course is to develop skills in using AEDs, suction, airway management equipment, oxygen during resuscitation and to administer oxygen to a conscious or unconscious patient. It also includes advanced bleeding management.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 15 years of age at date of assessment
- Proficient in **ONE** of the following awards:
 - o Bronze Medallion
 - o Apply (Senior) First Aid/First Aid [AID]
 - o Resuscitation Certificate

When:

Saturday 23rd September 8:30am – all day

Saturday 25th November 8:30am – all day

Course #3 TBA as required 8:30am – all day

RESUSCITATION CERTIFICATE

HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Overview:

The aim of this course is to develop skills in CPR.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 10 years of age at date of assessment

When:

As required by Club Training Officer

Other courses run in conjunction with First Aid courses only.

SILVER MEDALLION – IRB DRIVER

PUASAR014 Operate and maintain a small powercraft and motor for rescue operations

PUAEQU001 Prepare, maintain, and test response equipment

Overview:

The aim of this course is to help you develop knowledge and skills to safely and effectively drive an Inflatable Rescue Boat.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 17 years of age at date of assessment
- Hold current Qld Recreational Marine Licence
- Proficient in **BOTH** of the following awards:
 - o Bronze Medallion
 - o IRB Crew Certificate

When:

Saturday & Sunday 7th & 8th October and Saturday 15th October

Saturday & Sunday 2nd, & 3rd December and Saturday 9th Dec

Course #3:- TBA if required after the Christmas break.

IRB CREW CERTIFICATE

PUASAR015 Crew small powercraft in a rescue operation

Overview:

The aim of this course is to help you develop skills and knowledge to effectively participate as crew in rescues using an IRB.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 15 years of age at date of assessment
- Proficient in Bronze Medallion

When:

Saturday & Sunday 7th & 8th October and Saturday 15th October

Saturday & Sunday 2nd, & 3rd Dec. and Saturday 9th December

Course #3:- TBA if required after the Christmas break.

SILVER MEDALLION PATROL CAPTAIN

PUATEA002B work autonomously; PUAOPE027A Undertake beach safety management activities; BSBFLM312C Contribute to team effectiveness.

Overview:

This course is aimed at experienced lifesavers wanting to be a patrol captain or lifeguard. It is an extension of basic principles learnt in the Bronze Medallion course and equips members to be an entry level beach manager and team leader.

Entry Requirements:

- At least 17 years of age at date of assessment
- Hold a Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)
- Be proficient in **ONE** of the following awards:
 - o Bronze Medallion
 - o Provide First Aid/First Aid [AID]
 - o Radio Operator Certificate
 - o Advanced Resuscitation Techniques [AID]

When: Conducted by Surf Life Saving Wide Bay Capricorn Branch; Eligible candidates will be notified.

TO ENROL IN A COURSE YOU MUST:

- **Be an active, financial member of the Club**
- **Have completed the CYRMS and CSA child safety Training**
- **HAVE A CURRENT WORKING WITH CHILDREN BLUE CARD, (OVER 18), not just applied for one**

SURF RESCUE CERTIFICATE

Overview:

This course is aimed at members wanting to participate on patrol or as water safety personnel for Surf Sports or Junior Activities. The SRC is a steppingstone towards a Bronze Medallion, with less demanding assessment tasks. The aim of the course is to develop basic skills about surf awareness, rescue and patrols. This qualification includes a Resuscitation course (HLTAID009).

Entry Requirements:

- At least 13 years of age at date of assessment
- 200m pool swim in under 5 minutes

When:

Course #2: Sunday – Thursday 17th – 21st September
Course #3: Sundays 22nd, 29th October; 12th, 19th, 26th November

OBSERVERS CERTIFICATE

Overview:

This course is aimed at members wanting to develop their knowledge of surf awareness and skills to enable them to read the surf, identify risks, hazards and people in difficulty in the surf. **This the minimum pre-requisite to become a Juniors' Age Manager.**

Entry Requirements:

- Financial club member
- At least 15 years of age at date of assessment

When:

Saturday 16th September 2:00pm – 4:00pm

SKILLS MAINTENANCE

Bronze Medallion, Resuscitation, Radio, Advanced Resuscitation Techniques, Surf Rescue Certificate.

Information:

You will be unable to participate in the Skills Maintenance practical tasks until you have completed your Online Theory Questions (instructions included in email) and have a copy of the completion certificate when you arrive on the day.
(Takes about 10 min)

NOTE:

- 1. ANY MEMBER WHO FAILS TO COMPLETE THEIR SKILLS MAINTENANCE BY 31ST DECEMBER WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PATROL UNTIL THEY HAVE DONE SO.**
- 2. ANY PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLETE THEIR SKILLS MAINTENANCE FOR BRONZE MEDALLION AND/OR SURF RESCUE CERTIFICATE BY 31ST DECEMBER MUST COMPLETE THE REQUIRED POOL SWIM PRIOR TO PROCEEDING WITH SKILLS MAINTENANCE (BM 400m under 9min; SRC 200m under 5min).**
NB. CTO must gain SLSQ approval prior to completing late Skills Maintenance.
- 3. ANY PERSON WHO DOES NOT COMPLETE THEIR SKILLS MAINTENANCE BY DECEMBER 31ST WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE AT ANY CARNIVAL UNTIL JULY 1ST.**
4. If you have not completed a Skills Maintenance for a number of years, you may have to complete the entire Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate course to be considered proficient again. Check with the Chief Training Officer.
